### HISTORY AND TRADITIONS.

The regiment was raised in 1715. It served in the West Indies, 1796-8, and took part in the Maroon War. It took part in the Peninsular War, 1810-14, and served with distinction at Albuhera, Arroyo dos Molinos, Badajos, Vittoria, Orthes, and Toulouse, and numerous other engagements. It again distinguished itself at Waterloo, and marched with the Army of Occupation to Paris. It went to Bulgaria on the outbreak of the Russian War and afterwards to the Crimea, and was present at Alma and Inkerman. It was one of the regiments of the Light Brigade in the famous Balaklava charge and afterwards served before Sevastopol. It went to Natal in 1894, and was afterwards with Sir Charles Warren in the Bechuanaland Expedition. During the South African War it took part in the desperate fighting in the early part of the campaign in Natal leading up to the Relief of Ladysmith, and served with distinction throughout the war.
